

Remove OEM


1.Take out the plastic cover on the gearbox from both side with pry tool



3.Rendering after take out the cover of gearbox




5.Use the screwdriver and insert from the top of the glove box and remove the scree of the airbag



2.pull out the plastic cover and unplug the cigarette lighter ,AUX and other wires



4.Open the glove box on passenger side, press the buckles on both sides to the inside and open the glove box



6.Pick up the airbag and unscrew the screw shown on the circled postion



7.Unscrew the top screw on the top of dashboard. Use the fry tool to take it out.



9.Use the fry tool to disassemble the A/C outlets from OEM unit





8.Use the fry tool to remove the plastic board under the cigarette lighter



10.Use the fry tool to take out the bottom cover of the storage box above the OEM unit





12.Use the fry tool to take out the OEM unit bezel, be careful not to broken the wire




13.Take out the hazard light and pull out the wire













17.Remove the OEM unit brain and screen, pull out the wire




1.Take out the vertical screen unit and plug the wire like below




3.Connect the unit power-cord to the OEM CD power-cord




2.Connect OEM radio antenna adapter to OEM radio antenna



4.Connect the unit bezel light cable to OEM bezel light cable



5.Connect the unit protocol line to the OEM protocol line, also connect to the OBD line



7.Connect the USB cable one side to the glove box the other side to the USB lower cover



6.Connect the OBD cable to the OBD connector under the bottom of driver side shown below



8.Put back the Android vertical screen to the OEM unit position



9.Use 2 screws to fix the upper end of the android vertical screen unit



10.Use 2 screws to fix the bottom end of the android vertical screen unit





12.Put back the OEM plastic cover and screw to fix



12.Place the USB lower cover to the bottom of the unit



13.Put back the passenger airbag, glove box and gear box cover to finish the installation
